

PROVIDENCE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (PCA) COURT RULES

This is an unattended “play-at-your-own- risk” facility - there is no supervisor on duty. Use of the facility is at the sole risk of the individual using the facility. Parents/guardians are responsible for the safety and care of their minor children and assume all risk(s) in this regard.

IN THE EVENT OF A SERIOUS INJURY OR LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCY, CALL 911 and then call the management company at (281) 537-0957

Any injury occurring in the court area must be reported to the management company immediately.

The PCA assumes no liability for injuries or damages. Due to the strenuous nature of some activities, the participant is advised to consult his/her physician concerning fitness to participate. All activities present certain inherent risks and hazards which the participant assumes.

The Providence Tennis / Pickleball Courts are private courts for use by Providence residents and their accompanied Guests only. **Guests must be accompanied by a resident.**

PCA Directors have authority to enforce all court rules.

Residents who repeatedly violate the rules may be ejected. The first violation will suspend entry to the pool for 60 consecutive days. The second violation will suspend entry to the pool for 6 months and third suspension for one year.

PCA is not responsible for personal property or valuables at any time.

All owners/tenants/residents are required to complete a release of liability form on an annual basis and return the form to the management company. A Providence resident is eligible to utilize the tennis courts provided the resident: (1) has purchased a key (\$20) to the tennis court gates (only one key is allowed per resident address or family), and (2) has no delinquency in annual assessments nor any balance due to the Providence Community Association. The two (2) gate locks are re-keyed annually.

SAFETY / COURTESY RULES

1. For safety reasons, children aged 9 and under must be accompanied by a qualified resident at least 16 years of age.
2. Only one court may be used at a time by a qualified resident and their Guest(s).
3. **Maximum number of Guests for a single qualified resident is three (3)**, presuming a single resident playing doubles on the allowed one court. Maximum number of Guests for a qualified resident couple is two (2), presuming a resident couple playing doubles on the allowed one court.
4. **Court keys may not be loaned or gifted to non-residents.**
Texas Driver's License, and court key must be shown (when requested by a PCA Board member) in the possession and name of the qualified Providence resident. If not, the group will be requested to leave the courts immediately. **Players using the PCA courts without a resident present are trespassing and may be prosecuted.**

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5. Spectators and ice chests are not to be on the Courts but should use the Picnic Table and / or concrete pad provided.
6. Playing time is limited to:
 - a. One (1) hour for an individual or lessons
 - b. One and one-half (1-1/2) hours for singles
 - c. Two (2) hours for doubles
7. Tennis shoes must be worn on the courts. No other shoes are allowed.
8. No non-tennis playing children are allowed on the courts, for their own safety.
8. No skateboards, bicycles, roller skates, roller blades, pets, food, glass containers, ice chests or chairs are allowed on the courts. The courts are for tennis & pickleball only.
9. Court Hours of allowed play are 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
10. All Resident players shall ensure that the gates are locked both during play and when leaving the courts upon completion of play.
11. All players shall properly dispose of any trash and plastic bottles in the receptacles provided after completion of play and upon leaving the courts.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Only Courts 1 & 2 may be used for Tennis or Pickleball Tournament play. Court 3 must be available for other Residents.
2. The Resident scheduling the Tournament must rent the Clubhouse and adhere to all Rental Agreements.
3. Tournament play must not exceed three (3) hours without a minimum one (1) hour break which might allow another Resident to use the Court.
4. All Rules above apply with Court time of #6 being the only exception.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to revise these rules without prior notice.
