

West Keegans Bayou Improvement District Taxpayer/Voter Notice

Please be advised that Director Verma, current President of West Keegans Bayou Improvement District (WKBID) running for re-election May 2, received this notice regarding enforcement action (fine assessed against WKBID and to be paid for out of your taxpayer funds) on or about April 17, 2026.

Director Verma did not share complete information on this action, or violation letter he received (dated January 5, 2026,) with the rest of the Board and is still in denial that any wrongdoing has occurred. This Order was shared with all current Directors this morning (April 28, 2026). Apparently, only Director Verma, his preferred consulting firm/service provider, and legal were cognizant of the details; the rest of the Board was not given the opportunity to comment on or share input in the response to TCEQ.

Director Verma ignored multiple warnings from another Director that it appeared that permit reporting/responsibility requirements were not being handled correctly and that no Storm Water Management Plan was available for the Board or taxpayers to access (suggesting that there was no plan).

This is not someone you want to re-elect on May 2.

Director Verma's current "team" running mates, Robert Reko and Marie J. Hampton, are not well informed on WKBID's charter/responsibilities or this enforcement action either. They will follow Verma's lead, and residents/taxpayers certainly don't need any more poor stewardship of this flood control district.
